## How can you help your child?

- Your child will bring a library book home every night.
- Please listen to your child read their reading book on a regular basis. Also, talk to your son or daughter about what they have read. This will help with their progress in reading and comprehension.
- Your child has had free choice with their library book. These are designed for you to share – maybe you could read it to them and then discuss what has been read.
- Please ask your child what they have been doing in maths each day.
- Maths is everywhere! Encourage your son or daughter to calculate change when going shopping, measure out ingredients when cooking or work out how much time they have left before bedtime.

## Year 4 Spring Learning

Welcome back to the Spring term . We hope you had a lovely Christmas break.

This leaflet offers information about what your child will be learning this term. If you wish to know more, please speak to a member of staff from your child's class.

## English

In English, we are learning the skills for story writing, poetry and non-fiction. We will concentrate on developing use of punctuation, powerful vocabulary, more interesting sentence types and spellings.

The above skills will be taught through the context of a class novel. We are reading 'The BFG' by Roald Dahl.

To help your child at home, ask them about the work they have been doing at school - ask them to talk about the books read.

## Theme

This term, we will be finding out about The Tudors. We will investigate Tudor houses and learn about Kings and Queens of that time period.

In art we will be designing and making our own Tudor houses and portraits.

Help your child by visiting local libraries and borrow books about the Tudors.

## Maths

In maths, we will continue to develop our maths skills through Maths Makes Sense.

In arithmetic, we will calculate maths stories for all four operations with mixed numbers – using this to calculate answers to word problems. In geometry, we will learn how to draw circles using a pair of compasses and measure diameter and circumference.

In data and measure we will solve word problems using quantities involving decimals, time problems and presenting data in graphs.

## Science

In science, the children will be learning about electrical circuits and investigating common conductors and insulators using different materials.

We will observe and name a variety of sources of sound and how they are made.

## RE & PSHE

In PSHE, the children will learn how to cope with feelings and different situations. They will learn about cooperation and how they can change their own mindsets in situations in and out of school.

In RE, the children will be continuing to focus on Christianity. They will look at stories in the Bible leading up to Easter and in Islam we will learn about prophets.
