Welcome back to the Summer term. We hope you had a lovely Easter break. The next few weeks of the term are essential in learning key skills in preparation for Year five. Your child needs to remain focused and motivated so that they can gain the best from their time in school. Please ensure that your child attends school on time each day.

This leaflet offers information about what your child will be learning this term. If you wish to know more, please speak to a member of staff from your child's class.

English

In English, we are learning the skills for story writing, poetry and non-fiction. We will concentrate on developing use of punctuation, sentence types and a range of vocabulary.

The above skills will be taught through the context of a class novel. We are reading 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Murpurgo.

Encourage your child to use their best handwriting at all times.

Theme

Maths

In maths, we will continue to develop our maths skills through Maths Makes Sense.

In arithmetic, we will be focusing our calculation on two step problems, fractions and quantities.

In geometry, we will be drawing and naming types of triangles.

In data and measure, we will solve word problems using quantities involving decimals and have a focus on learning how to tell the time.

Science

In science, the children will be learning about living things.

We will look at how plants grow and the conditions needed to maintain growth.

Your child will be researching various habitats and the types of plants and animals that can survive there.

RE & PSHE

In PSHE, the children will discuss why money plays a part in their lives. We will discuss employment, skills and why spending is or is not essential.

In RE, the children will be learning about Buddhism as our theme later in the term will be about Ancient China.
