29th April to the 10th May People Who help Us

During these two weeks we will be thinking about our local community and the people in it who help us. The children will learn about police, firefighters, dentists, doctors and more. The children will get the chance to use a super soaker to pretend to be Fire fighters!

At home you could talk about the different people who help us and how they help us. You could talk to your child about what to do if they ever need the emergency services. If you have a friend or relative who has one of these jobs your child could talk to them about what it is like.



13th May to the 24th May The Three Little Pigs

Over these two weeks, the children will be reading the traditional story, 'The Three Little Pigs.' We will talk about the different characters in the story and retell the story in our own words. The children will also explore the different materials the pigs used to build their houses.

At home, you could read different versions of this story. The children could use different materials to design their own house and bring this in to share with us!



27th May to the 31st May We are Scientists!

During this Science based week we are going to be engaging in a range of experiments involving melting and freezing, speed and sound. The children are going to be using different science equipment and carry out investigations themselves.


At home, talk to them about the experiments they have done and what they have found out. You could also carry out your own investigation by seeing who can get an ice cube to melt the fastest.



10th to the 21st June Goldilocks and the Three Bears

During these two weeks the children will be reading the story and talking about the different characters and their feelings. We will also be looking at changing the ending to the traditional story.


We will also be holding our very own teddy bear's picnic which we would love to invite you to!

8th July to the 22nd July Summer

During the last two weeks in Reception we will be learning all about the summer and different holidays. The children will be writing postcards and exploring the different places you could visit.

We will also be preparing the children for moving into Year 1 and they will have the opportunity to meet their new teacher and spend time in their new classroom to help prepare them for September.
