Reading	<p><b>Prediction on Who Let the Gods Out?</b></p> <p><i>Have a look at the cover and blurb of our new class text. Go through the video carefully and follow the instructions to carry out your tasks. Pause the video in order to complete your task and press play again when you are ready to move on.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Video</a></p>	<p><b>Retrieving information and inferring: Hercules</b></p> <p><i>Watch the video below to work through the lesson slides. Read the poem, then answer the questions. Remember to pause the video when you need to complete a task and then press play when you are ready to carry on.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Video</a></p>	<p><b>What is Heaven? Poem – Mixed Skills</b></p> <p><i>In this lesson you will be reading a poem called “What is Heaven?” and you will then work on some mixed skills questions about it. Writing	<p><b>Ottava Rima poetry:</b></p> <p><i>Have a look at the slides to find out what an Ottava Rima poem is and their features. Then we will generate some vocabulary to use for when we write one ourselves. There are some links within the PowerPoint with resources to help you generate your vocabulary.</i></p> <p><a href="#">PowerPoint</a></p>	<p><b>Writing: Ottava Rima Poem Shared Write</b></p> <p><i>You will be recapping the features of an Ottava Rima poem today and then watching how I have written mine in order to help you with the independent write you will be doing tomorrow.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Video</a></p>	<p><b>Independent Write of an Ottava Rima Poem</b></p> <p><i>Work through the slides and use your work from last lesson to write your own Ottava Rima poem! Maths	<p><b>Parallel and Perpendicular Lines/ Perimeter</b></p> <p><i>Watch the video to work through the slides and we will work on identifying different types of lines, then recap finding the perimeter of shapes. Pause the video in order to complete your task and press play again when you are ready to move on.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Video</a></p>	<p><b>Calculating with fractions</b></p> <p><i>Recap your learning from Autumn term about adding and subtracting with fractions. Read the slides carefully and have a go at the questions. If you are feeling confident, make sure you are challenging yourself with the reasoning and problem-solving questions.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Video</a></p>	<p><b>Ratio</b></p> <p><i>This term you will be introduced to ratio. Make sure you read the slides carefully and work out each step so that you don’t miss any steps. Pause the video if you need to.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Video</a></p>
Wider Curriculum	<p><b>Wider Curriculum – RE</b></p> <p><i>Our new RE unit is on different parables and how we can learn lessons from them. In today’s lesson you will look at how we can figure out what the moral of a story is by reading a fable, watching an animated video of a Christian parable and filling in a moral table.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Video</a></p>	<p><b>Wider Curriculum – Theme</b></p> <p><i>In this lesson you’ll be introduced to our new theme topic and will begin to build a foundation of knowledge ready to pull on over coming weeks as we work through the topic further... there is even a game to help you learn more about it! Watch the video below, remembering to pause when needed.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Video</a></p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p><i>This term you will be looking at animals, including humans. Wellbeing	<p><b>PE</b></p> <p><i>This week in PE you will be looking at the rules of tennis, but tennis with a difference. This is called floor tennis. You can use some of your own experiences too. Once you have watched the video, complete the following sheets.
