<b>Reading</b>	<p><b>The Butterfly Lion</b> Read the extract from 'The Butterfly Lion'. Look at the Vocabulary check. Use a dictionary to find definitions of any other new words.</p> <p><a href="#">Extract</a> <a href="#">Vocabulary Check</a></p>	<p><b>Retrieval Practice</b> Use the extract from yesterday to help you answer the questions below. Remember to fetch the answers from the text.</p> <p><a href="#">Questions</a></p>	<p><b>Inference Practice</b> Use the extract from yesterday to help you answer the questions below. Remember to look for clues in the text and use evidence where possible.</p> <p><a href="#">Questions</a></p>	<p><b>Vocabulary Focus</b> It is really important to understand the vocabulary in extracts you are reading. Have a go at the questions below, using the extract from Wednesday to help you.</p> <p><a href="#">Questions</a></p>	<p><b>Summarising and Predicting</b> Can you summarise effectively? <b>Writing</b>	<p><b>Non-Chronological Reports</b> Remind yourself of the features of a non-chronological report. Watch the video about pigeons used in WW1 – Take notes.</p> <p><a href="#">Features of a NCR</a> <a href="#">Pigeons during the war</a></p>	<p><b>Starting to write a NCR</b> Write a heading for a non-chronological report about pigeons in WW1. Use the information to write the introductory paragraph. Use your video notes, too.</p> <p><a href="#">Guidance</a></p>	<p><b>Writing the first section</b> Read the information and write a subheading. Use the notes to write about what pigeons were used for. Don't forget to use your video notes, too.</p> <p><a href="#">Guidance</a></p>	<p><b>Cher Ami</b> Watch the video again, taking special notice of 'Cher Ami'. Write a subheading and then write about what Cher Ami did during the war.</p> <p><a href="#">Information Video</a></p>	<p><b>Finishing Touches</b> Add a 'Did You Know?' box to include some interesting facts. Add in some photos/drawings with captions to make your non-chronological report more interesting.</p>
<b>Maths</b>	<p><b>Converting Measurements</b> Use the lesson below to practise converting between mm, cm, m and km. Think carefully about how to multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 100 – use the videos to recap if you need to!</p> <p><a href="#">Measures Lesson</a> <a href="#">Multiplying</a> or <a href="#">Dividing by 10/100/1000</a></p>	<p><b>Properties of 2D Shapes</b> Consolidate your understanding of 2D shapes and their properties by following the lesson below. <b>Wider Curriculum</b>	<p><b>Thematic - Singing</b> Why not have a go at learning these World War One songs and perform them to your family?</p> <p><a href="#">Music</a> <a href="#">Lyrics</a></p>	<p><b>Thematic - Poppies</b> Find out more about the significance of a poppy and remembrance day. Write an acrostic poem using the word 'POPPIES'.</p> <p><a href="#">Information</a></p>	<p><b>Science – Melting and Freezing</b> Use the video and activities to learn more about changing states by melting and freezing. Then, have a go at completing the investigation sheet with an adult.</p> <p><a href="#">Information</a> <a href="#">Investigation</a></p>	<p><b>Science – Reversible or Irreversible Changes?</b> A reversible change is one that can be changed back; an irreversible change is one that cannot. Use the information to help you and complete the investigation with an adult.</p> <p><a href="#">Information</a> <a href="#">Investigation</a></p>	<p><b>Thematic – Art</b> In World War 1, spotlights were used to warn the British that the enemy was coming. Look at the ideas and create a piece of art work.</p> <p><a href="#">Art Ideas</a></p>
<b>Wellbeing</b>	<p><b>How do you feel?</b> It is important to reflect and keep track of your feelings throughout the week. Use the chart to help identify how you feel. Talk to a trusted adult about how you are feeling.</p> <p><a href="#">Feelings Chart</a></p>	<p><b>Reducing Stress</b> Remember to stay relaxed, even in these unusual times.
